## Notice of Race

### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 For protests where a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

### 2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the Sunburst class.
- 2.2 All entrants must be financial members of a club recognised by the entrant's national authority and a member of the Canterbury Sunburst Association.
- 2.3 Boats may be entered in the Open or Non-spinnaker fleet.
- 2.4 Entry forms will be available at Registration.
- 2.5 The entry fee for both days of the championship is \$30. A single day entry fee is \$20.
- 2.6 Eligible boats may enter by presenting a completed entry form and the relevant entry fee at Registration.
